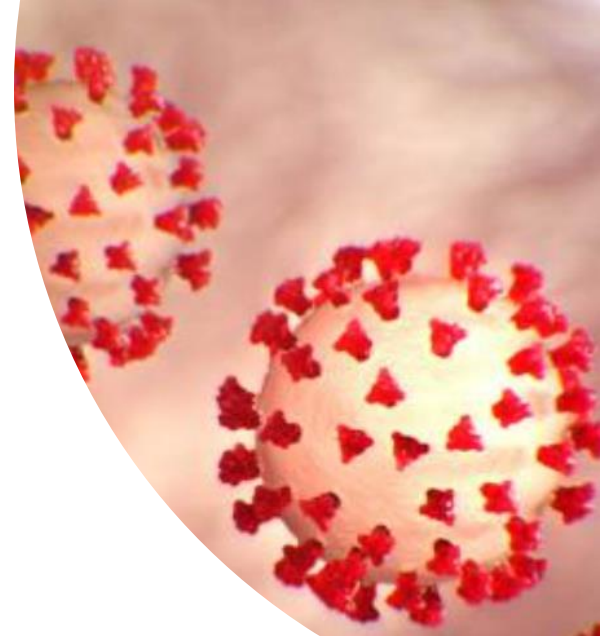

Reopening the County

- Currently in "Baseline" (pre-phase 1)
- Final criteria in progress – Contact tracing
 - Signed contract and working on hiring
 - Do not need to have all 100ish contact tracers to apply for reopening
- Applying for reopening – Friday May 22nd
 - Goal to reopen by June 1st (not set in stone!)
- No approval process for businesses

Guidance Themes

- Employees must wear face coverings
 - Employers must provide face coverings
- Encourage customers to wear face coverings
- Post signs/posters
- Extensive hand washing and cleaning procedures
- 6 feet of distance

- Health care offices must supply own PPE for reopening
- Businesses must provide face coverings for employees
 - Do you know what supplies you need?
- KN95 masks are not NIOSH certified (for medical use)
